

Nevada Farm Bureau Policy On Nevada Water Conservation Program:

#### "Nevada Farm Bureau supports

appropriate management of agricultural irrigation water and conservation measures which provide for proper management of water resources which maintain the long-term ability of a water basin to not exceed perennial yield levels. Agricultural irrigation water use should not exceed the duties associated with a water right...."





Nevada Farm Bureau Policy On Nevada Water Conservation Program:

#### "Attention needs to be directed at

addressing over-appropriated groundwater basins with solutions oriented to bringing water rights and water being pumped into balance with perennial yields. Ongoing monitoring reports need to be shared with water right owners in the groundwater basin to assist in a better understanding of the conditions and status of the groundwater basin..."





Nevada Farm Bureau Policy On Nevada Water Conservation Program:

#### "Conservation and irrigation efficiency

by an agricultural water right owner is already addressed without government involvement because of the costs and economic self-interest of the water right owner who has significant investments associated with the infrastructure and operations of applying irrigation water for beneficial use."





Nevada Farm Bureau Policy On Treatment of Water Rights

"The right to use water is a property right which should not be taken away from an owner without due process and just compensation at the highest valued use...."
