- Founded 1999
- Nevada-based, not-for-profit
- Institution of higher education focused on health professions
- Branch campus in South Jordan, Utah
- New campus in Summerlin
- Enrollment: 1,450
- Employees: 530

Roseman Timeline

- 1999—Incorporated in the state of Nevada
- 2001—First PharmD class enters
- 2003—First PharmD class graduates
- 2005—First MBA class enters
- 2006—First BSN class enters
- 2006—First PharmD class enters at South Jordan
- 2009—First Orthodontic residents enter
- 2010—First BSN class enters at South Jordan
- 2011—First DMD class enters at South Jordan
- 2013—Acquisition of Engelstad building, "Summerlin campus"; future home of College of Medicine
- 2015—MD program receives Candidate accreditation status from LCME
- 2017—First MD students enter (projected)

Roseman Quality

- Health Professions Degree Programs require Board licensure in order to practice after graduation
- In order to obtain Board licensure, graduates must pass a licensure exam
- Most recent Roseman first-time passing rates:

• DMD program: 98.4%

PharmD program: 96.4%

BSN program: 94.6%

• Orthodontic residency: 100%

Roseman Quality

- Most recent US Dept of Education Student Loan Cohort default rate (3 year period ending FY12) = 0.5%
- National average for private, not-for-profit universities = 6.8%
- Nevada average = 14.2%

- Pre-eminent medical research capability which is growing
- Areas of focus:
 - Oncology
 - Alzheimer's and other neurodegenerative diseases
 - · Diabetes and Obesity
 - Substance Abuse and Depression
- Nationally and internationally recognized and published researchers

Roseman Gives Back to the Community

- Free screenings at health fairs around the region
 - Over a one year period, Roseman students and faculty at health fairs performed:
 - 1,320 blood glucose screenings (105 out of range)
 - 757 blood pressure screenings (179 out of range)
 - 462 blood cholesterol screenings (143 out of range)
 - Biennial health screening at Nevada Legislature since 2007—Save the date <u>Feb. 14, 2017</u>

Roseman Gives Back to the Community

- Participation in immunization clinics
 - From September through October 2015, Roseman students and faculty immunized <u>1,098</u> Nevada residents against influenza and pneumococcus
- "Give a Kid a Smile"
 - Orthodontic residents have participated in this program for 7 years
 - In 2015, record breaking <u>168</u> low income children received free dental exams and X-rays
- Medicare Call Center
 - Roseman faculty and students who receive classroom training supplemented with training from the Nevada SHIP office provide unbiased information regarding Medicare Plan Options to seniors.
 - Currently fielding 20-25 calls per month

Roseman Values Our Veterans

 Roseman's College of Nursing was the only institution in the Intermountain West (one of only 30 nationwide) to receive a \$1.05 million HRSA grant to support military veterans' transition into high demand professional nursing careers.

College of Medicine

- ➤ LCME site visit Feb 21-24, 2016
- ➤ June 2016 LCME will decide regarding preliminary accreditation
- Once receive accreditation, we can recruit students
- Target start for first class is August 2017 with 60 students

GME (Graduate Medical Education) Residency

- Pre-Medicine
- Undergraduate Medical Education 3-4 yrs
 - Leads to the MD or DO
 - Taught Basic Sciences (ex, anatomy, physiology, etc) & Clinical Sciences (practice of medicine)
- Graduate Medical Education (GME) 3-6 yrs
 - Examples:
 - **≻**Pediatrician
 - ➤ Ob-Gyn
 - > Family Medicine
 - **≻**Surgeon

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Importance of GME

- All students upon graduation with their MD or DO must do a residency in order to get the training they need to practice medicine in their specialty.
- Learning is under supervision.
- Prepare for specialty board certification.
- Increases the likelihood a graduate will eventually practice in the state!

GME
