



DSD Accreditations

- National Commission on Mental Health Care (NCCHC)
 - Currently accredited by NCCHC for medical services.
 - Specialized mental health accreditation received March 2021.
 - Full facility re-accreditation medical survey & audit September 2021.

 - Currently accredited by ACA.
 - Full facility re-accreditation survey & audit projected for September 2022.



Mental Health Medication





Mental Health Staffing

- The mental health team is comprised of psychiatric registered nurses, masters level clinicians, a discharge planner, as well as PRN staff. There are 12 RNs and 14 masters level clinicians on the team.
- Psychiatry has 2 full time psychiatrists, 2 full time psychiatric nurse practitioners, as well as PRN staff.
- 24/7 coverage



Mental Health Programming

- Mental Health programming in housing units
 - 3E- MH rounding 1 x week; MH Group 2 x week
 - 4K- MH rounding 1 x week; MH Group 3 x week
 - 2ABG- MH Rounding 2 x week; MH Group 2 x week
 - Youthful Offenders- MH Group 1 x week.
 - Therapeutic and pro-social group settings.



Checks and Balances

- Weekly Restrictive Housing Meetings
 - Psych Services, medical, operations, courts, and administration present
- Continuous Quality Improvement (CQI) and critical review of all deaths and critical incidents.
- Monthly Medical Administrative Committee (MAC)



Detention Services Division

- Intake evaluations and monitoring
 - Medical and mental health screenings, alcohol/drug detox and medications prescribed.
 - Enhanced supervision in booking and towers, with constant video in high-risk areas.
- Housing, programming and re-entry
 - Classification assignments, programs availability to include group therapy.
 - Specialized medical and mental health housing, to include step down programs.
 - Connections with several community providers (e.g., VA, DMV, SNAMHS, SNHD, HFP, etc.).
 - Crisis Intervention Training for staff and substantial discharge planning for inmates.



Detention Services Division – Initiatives

- Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) / Opioid Treatment Program (OTP)
 - Comprehensive Medical and mental health treatment for those with substance abuse issues.
 - Medication assisted treatment; best practices for alcohol/drug withdrawal and treatment.
 - Application pending for full audit and accreditation of MAT/OTP Program at CCDC & NVC.
- Behavioral Health Projects
 - Integrated social work interns from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas in 2021.
 - Working toward UNLV psychiatrist fellowship program at CCDC.
 - Expand AOST Reality based training to include responding to inmates in crisis
