This letter is to inform all Adult Group Care Facilities (AGCFs) of the upcoming increase in Supplemental Security Income (SSI) payments for 2022. Beginning January 1, 2022, the federal SSI payment will increase 5.9 percent. The new schedule of payments for aged and blind individuals is as follows:

Federal Payment	State Payment	Total Payment	Personal Needs Allowance	Net to Operator
\$841.00	\$391.00	\$1,232.00	\$137.00	\$1,095.00

The Division of Welfare and Supportive Services policy requires that each client in an AGCF receive a personal needs allowance. For calendar year 2022, the Personal Needs Allowance will increase to \$137.00 per month. The balance (\$1,095.00) of the combined federal/state SSI payment is available for room and board costs. The personal needs allowance is set for all Medicaid eligible AGCF residents; however, subject to other agency contractual agreements, the AGCF may be required to allow a greater amount of personal needs.

A disabled individual's federal payment will be \$841, with no state supplement.
