Dear Chair Miller, Committee Members and Staff,

I am Dean Willmore, one of 26,000 Nevada voters supporting the Convention of States resolution. Chair Miller, I encourage you and the Committee members to consider submitting a resolution BDR for potential debate in the 2023 session. I strongly support the Article V Amendment process in our United States Constitution to help rein in an overreaching federal government. I am losing more freedoms and control over my life, especially when it comes to my Freedom of Speech and my Freedom of Religion. The United States has changed so much, I hardly recognize it anymore. Federal spending and our national debt are out of control, I was stigmatized and coerced to get a vaccine that doesn't work, inflation is at a 40-Year high and our children are being indoctrinated with Critical Race Theory and obscene sexual "instruction", instead of being given an education.
