Assembly Bill (AB) 231 Overview



AB 231 requires the State Board of Education to appoint a subcommittee to review and make recommendations on the manner in which to provide certain information to pupils concerning the Holocaust and other Genocides, such as the Armenian, Cambodian, Darfur, Guatemalan and Rwandan Genocides. Additionally, review the manner in which certain standards support comprehensive education on the Holocaust for educators and students, including resources and professional learning.

Recommendations to State Board of Education and Nevada Department of Education




- Build systemwide supports for all educators, families, and students
- Develop crosswalk of English Language Arts, Fine Arts, and Social Studies standards that address the Holocaust and other genocides topics
- Curate resources for educators on Holocaust and other genocides and host on website and state-wide LMS, Canvas
- Work collaboratively with the Governors' Advisory Council on Education Relating to the Holocaust
- Develop on-demand professional learning modules and maintain on Canvas
- Develop and support a professional learning network for educators

Legislative Recommendations



- Funding for an education programs professional at the Department of Education to build capacity in the area of the Holocaust and other Genocides
- Funding to develop professional learning and curate resources for educators in Nevada on the Holocaust and other Genocides
- Funding for school districts and charter schools to support substitute teacher coverage for teachers and administrators to participate in professional learning
