- 1. A list of K-12 schools with 20% or higher of African-American students in rank order from highest percentage to lowest.
- A breakdown of the numbers of licensed teachers and substitute teachers for each CCSD K-12 school. If this can be provided in rank order, of highest numbers of licensed teachers to the lowest, it would be appreciated.
- 3. The total numbers of students, district-wide by ethnicity on Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) with federal and general fund dollars spent by ethnicity.
- 4. Federal and general dollars spent, by subgroup, specifically ELL, FRL and IEP students and the numbers of students in each subgroup.
