Item V11. Amendment to Rules and Policies of the Legislative Counsel Bureau

PROPOSED REVISIONS TO THE RULES AND

POLICIES OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL BUREAU

Section 1. The Rules and Policies of the Legislative Counsel Bureau are hereby amended by adding a new rule to read as follows:

Rule No. 58. Use of Hearing and Meeting Rooms.

- 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 3, the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau shall provide for the hearing rooms in the Legislative buildings in Carson City and Las Vegas to be reserved in advance and used by any agency or office of State government, without charge, on a first-come, first-served basis, in the same manner as the Legislative Branch.
 - 2. The Director shall adopt a policy to ensure that each hearing is:
 - (a) Fully staffed by the Legislative Counsel Bureau; and
 - (b) Appropriately recorded and, upon request, broadcast.
- 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1, during a regular or special session of the Legislature, the Director shall ensure that priority in the reservation, assignment and use of the hearing rooms described in subsection 1 is afforded to ensure the availability of such hearing rooms as are necessary to conduct legislative business.
