Legislative Commission on Regulation Changes

I oppose the changes being proposed to our elections. I believe a less expensive and more secure method would be as follows:

Use mailed out ballots as paper ballots

Vote on Election Day only at the precinct level with valid ID with ballots hand counted.

No out of precinct voting allowed as the Supreme Court of the United States has ruled such as discrimination and unconstitutional under

Brnovich V. DNC No. 19-1257 and Arizona Republican Party V. DNC No.19-1258

Allow Caucuses again at the precinct level with hand counted paper ballots and valid ID.

Persons transporting ballots must be sworn election officials not anonymous couriers.

National elections in the past were conducted on one day with results posted that evening. Expanding this process by allowing multiple days to

vote and mass mail out ballots and failing to clean the voter rolls lead to inaccuracies and fraud.

I ask that you do not codify the various election functions on your agenda.
