 - Commissary markups and prices.
 - Medical costs and copays.
 - Room and board fees.
 - Communication fees.
 - How does the cost of incarceration in Nevada vary across the state?
- AB116 traffic decriminalization update from the courts
 - How is the bond fee working?
 - Number of citations that are being contested?
 - Number of driver licenses being suspended?
 - Who is suspending licenses for failure to pay?
 - Do courts offer a reduction in fines and fees without contestation?
- Updates on the implementation of legislation passed during the last session.
 - Free record sealing for victims of sex trafficking.
 - NDOC reforms.
 - Misdemeanor review sentencing commission.

We are happy to discuss any of these recommendations in more detail. We look forward to a productive interim session.
