

Science of Reading Projects

Oversight of the 2024 \$6 Million Expansion of the Science of Reading Across Nevada

- The Nevada PRESS Project (Path to Reading Excellence at School Sites): NDE is partnering with the University of Minnesota Center for Applied Research and Educational Improvement to offer a series of free professional learning cohorts in literacy for elementary educators. The content is aligned to the Science of Reading. PRESS will also offer a specific course for site administrators.
- The Modified Reading Endorsement and School Administrator Course Development Project: Nevada's RPDP Program was recently awarded the contract for this project. This work will modify courses listed in Nevada's NAC 391.285 "Endorsement to Teach Reading" by aligning them to the Science of Reading. An additional Science of Reading course will be developed specifically for Nevada school administrators. These asynchronous courses will be housed in NDE's online professional learning system where free remote access will be offered to educators.



Science of Reading Projects (continued)

- Nevada's 2024 Pre-K through Grade 12 Summer Literacy Institute: The University of Nevada, Reno was recently awarded a subgrant by NDE for conducting a three-day literacy institute titled *Integrating the Science of Reading into the Theory and Practice of Reading Instruction*. This Institute will establish a statewide level of understanding and classroom application of the Science of Reading for a cadre of 300 Nevada educators.
- The Nevada Substitute and Nevada Paraprofessional Educators Skills Development Program: Current and future Nevada substitutes and paraprofessionals will learn methods for supporting elementary students in the essential foundations of education, elementary literacy, and the development of critical reading skills in alignment to the Science of Reading. These programs will be offered by the College of Southern Nevada, Great Basin College, Truckee Meadows Community College, University of Nevada, Las Vegas, University of Nevada, Reno, and Western Nevada College.



Impact of Literacy Specialists

Designation of a Read by Grade 3 school literacy specialist at each public elementary schools is required by NRS 388.159

NDE does not currently have statutory authority to enforce that provision of NRS 388.159

An impact study will be conducted in fiscal year 2025
