



Guardianship in NV Prior to Reforms

- Seniors and adults with disabilities often placed in guardianship without knowledge or opportunity to be heard.
- Less restrictive alternatives not explored prior to imposition of guardianship.
- Guardians given total authority to make decisions without protected person's wishes or preferences considered.

Important Statutory Changes 2017

- Legal Counsel must be appointed for every protected person
- A Bill of Rights shall be created and enforceable through private right of action
- Protected Person is an active participant in the matter
- Change in perspective for various stakeholders regarding the Protected Persons' rights and ultimate goals of guardianship

Current Struggles

- Placement for clients with serious mental health diagnoses.
 - Need for intensive case management.
 - Mandated caregiver training
 - County funded group home Focus on serious mental health conditions.
 - Collect data on readmittance rates for these clients.
- Extended Hospital stays
 - Medicaid
 - Limited access to assets and information with banks and other financial institutions.
 - Placement, facilities not accepting "pending Medicaid" clients.

Policy Recommendation

- Less restrictive alternatives to Guardianship.
- Review private professional guardian guidelines.
- Expansion of 1915i program Waiver Programs.
- Mental Health Group Homes Waiver Programs.
