Re: Establishment of a Priority Matrix for Use in the Tahoe Regional Planning

Agency's (TRPA's) Decision-Making and Approval Processes

Dear Governing Board Members:

At the final meeting and work session of the Interim Legislative Committee for the Review and Oversight of the TRPA and the Marlette Lake Water System (MLWS) held on August 16, 2024, the Committee voted to send a letter to the TRPA encouraging the Agency to utilize the following order of priorities in its decision-making and approval processes under the Bi-State Compact:

- 1. Preservation, protection, and restoration of the Lake;
- 2. Enhancing the visitor experience;
- 3. Mitigating impacts on residents; and
- 4. Economic considerations.

Each application for development under the jurisdiction of the TRPA is unique and has varying elements and factors to be considered during the approval process. The purpose of this letter is to encourage the TRPA, by developing the priority matrix described above, to ask not only whether an application includes elements that may negatively impact Lake Tahoe, but also, does the proposed project in any way also: improve the preservation, protection or restoration of the Lake; enhance the visitor experience; mitigate impacts on residents; or effect economic considerations and apply these priorites, as may be applicable, to each application submitted for approval by the TRPA.

As Chair of the Legislative Committee for the Review and Oversight of the TRPA and the MLWS, I am respectfully requesting the TRPA be prepared to report any progress in regard to this issue to the Legislative Committee for the Review and Oversight of the TRPA and the MLWS during the 2025–2026 Interim.
