Re: item #5:

SB 78 of the 83rd Session (as introduced) creates great concern. A portion of the bill appears to infringe upon the present duties of the (Sunset) Subcommittee, insofar as the section in question appears to be duplicative. The disability community is among the topics which is on the chopping block in said bill.

While I can see B&I's intent behind the bill somewhat, I haven't personally been apart of any discussions to solicit stakeholder input regarding challenges that Boards/Commissions/Councils proposed to be eliminated, consolidated, etc. are experiencing to give a public perception that their work is duplicative, being performed in silos, etc.

In raising the concerns above, as usual, I express my willingness to work both with B&I and the Subcommittee's Chair to save the disability-based Boards/Commissions/Councils that are proposed to be eliminated, consolidated, etc.
