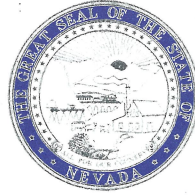

SUBJECT: **Solicitation of Recommendations**

The final meeting of Nevada's Legislative Committee on Education for the 2015-2016 Legislative Interim will be held on Wednesday, June 22, 2016. As in previous interims, Committee staff will be reviewing all meeting materials and testimony received at prior meetings and developing a list of recommendations for possible consideration by the Committee during the work session phase of its final meeting.

The Committee invites all interested parties to provide recommendations, in writing, for possible consideration by the Committee during the work session. The Committee has a limited allocation of bill draft requests (BDRs) for the 2017 Legislative Session. In addition to BDRs, the Committee may write letters to key individuals and organizations urging certain action, or include positional statements in the Committee's final report. Please note: Submission of a recommendation to the Committee does not guarantee its consideration during the work session.
