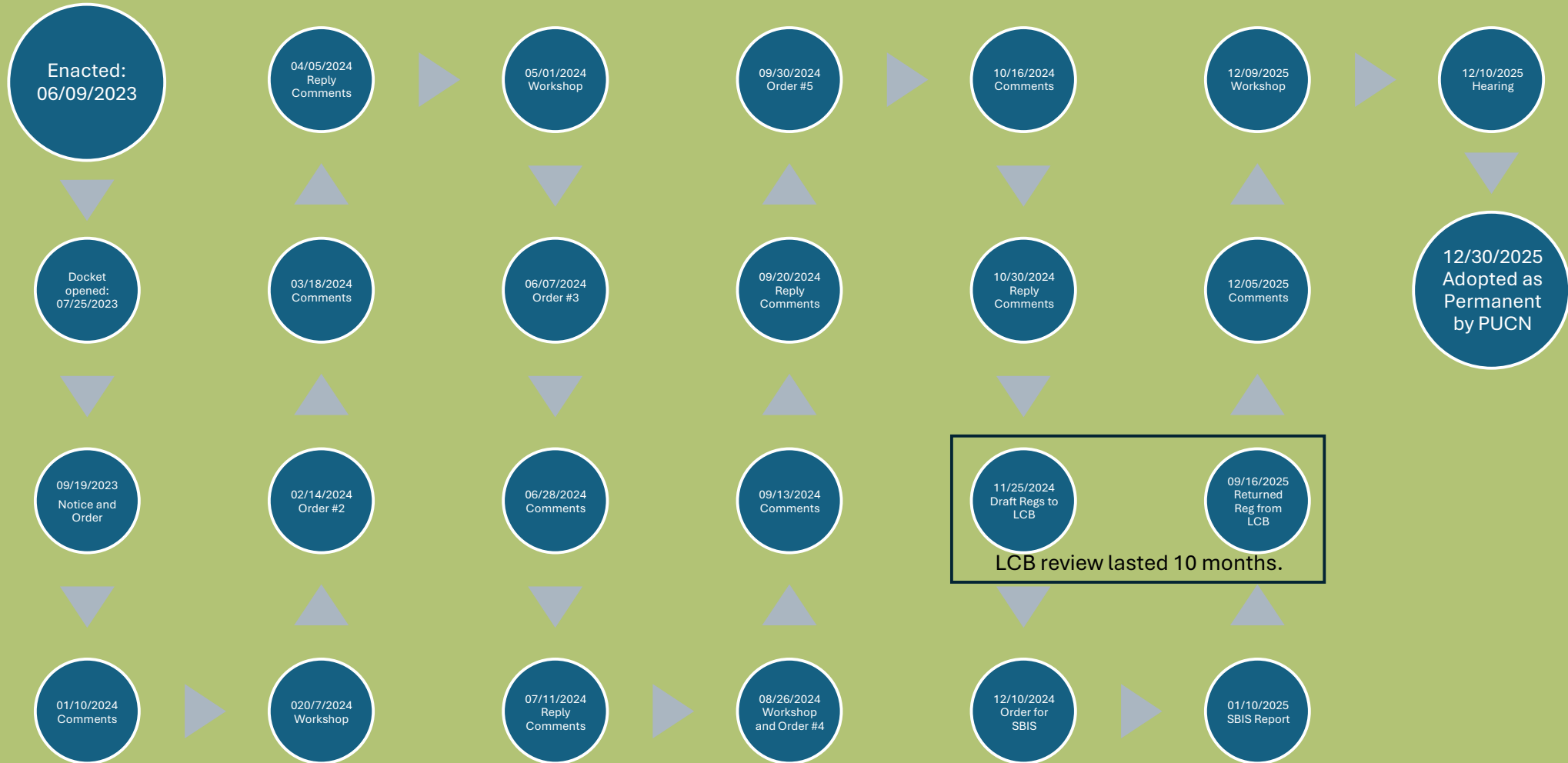

Rulemakings from 82nd (2023) Legislative Session

- Docket No. 23-07024 - Rulemaking to amend, adopt, and/or repeal regulations in accordance with Senate Bill 281 (2023).
 - Commenters: Southwest Gas, NV Energy, Western Resource Advocates, Advanced Energy United, Regulatory Operations Staff of the Commission, Nevada State Pipe Trades, Southwest Energy Efficiency Project, and the Southern Nevada Gaming Group.
 - Over 600 pages of comments
 - Three Commission-led workshops of over 3 hours 40 minutes
 - NRS 233B workshop and hearing
 - Final regulation: 42 pages
 - Complexity: Intense, highly complex interactions with existing regulations and statutes, thorough engagement by stakeholders.

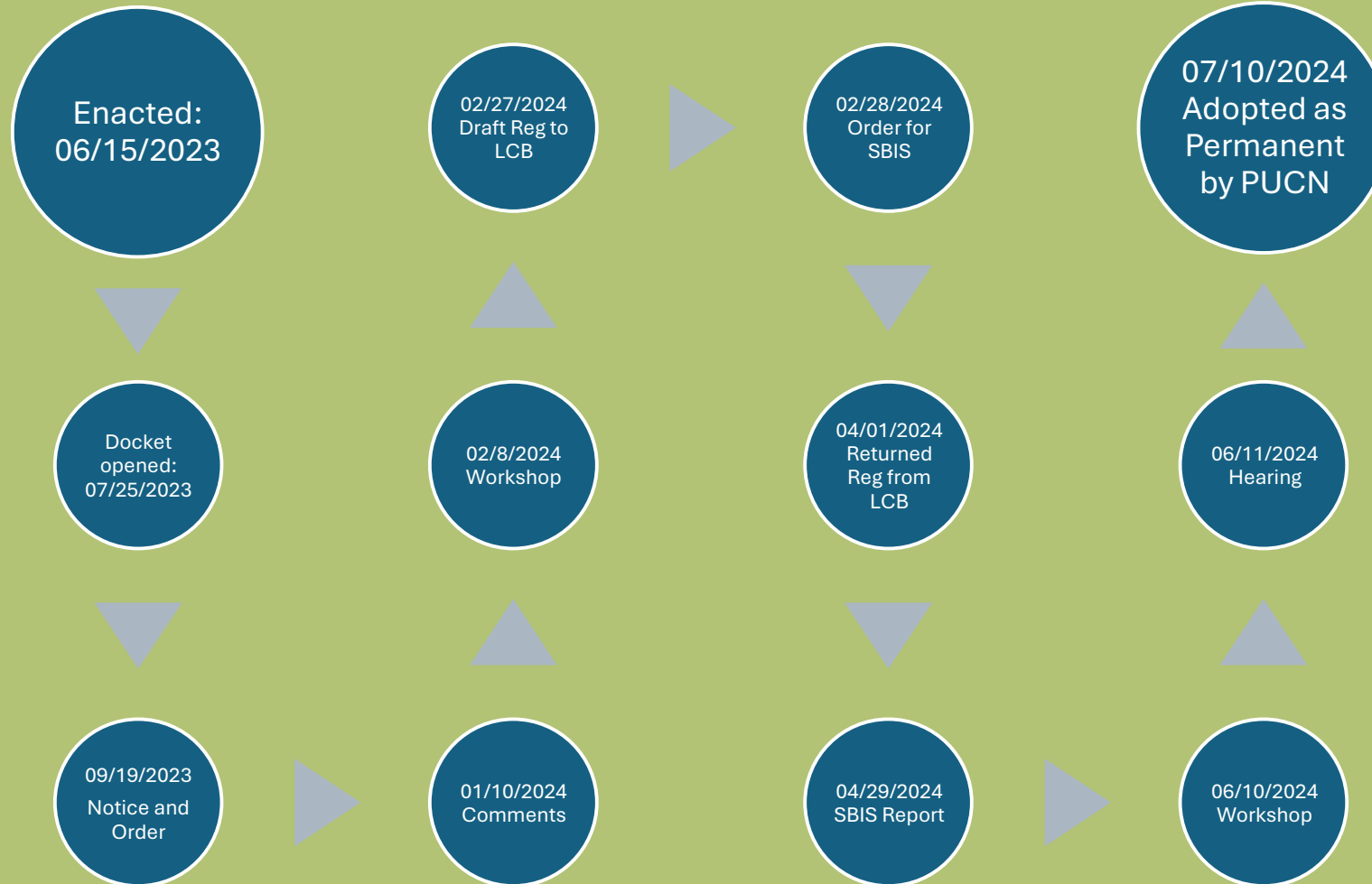
Docket No. 23-07024 – Timeline



Rulemakings from 82nd (2023) Legislative Session, cont.

- Docket No. 23-07025 - Rulemaking to amend, adopt, and/or repeal regulations in accordance with Assembly Bill 321 (2023).
 - Commenters: NV Energy, Regulatory Operations Staff of the Commission, and Bureau of Consumer Protection.
 - Final regulation: 1 page
 - Complexity: Straightforward, low impact regulations.

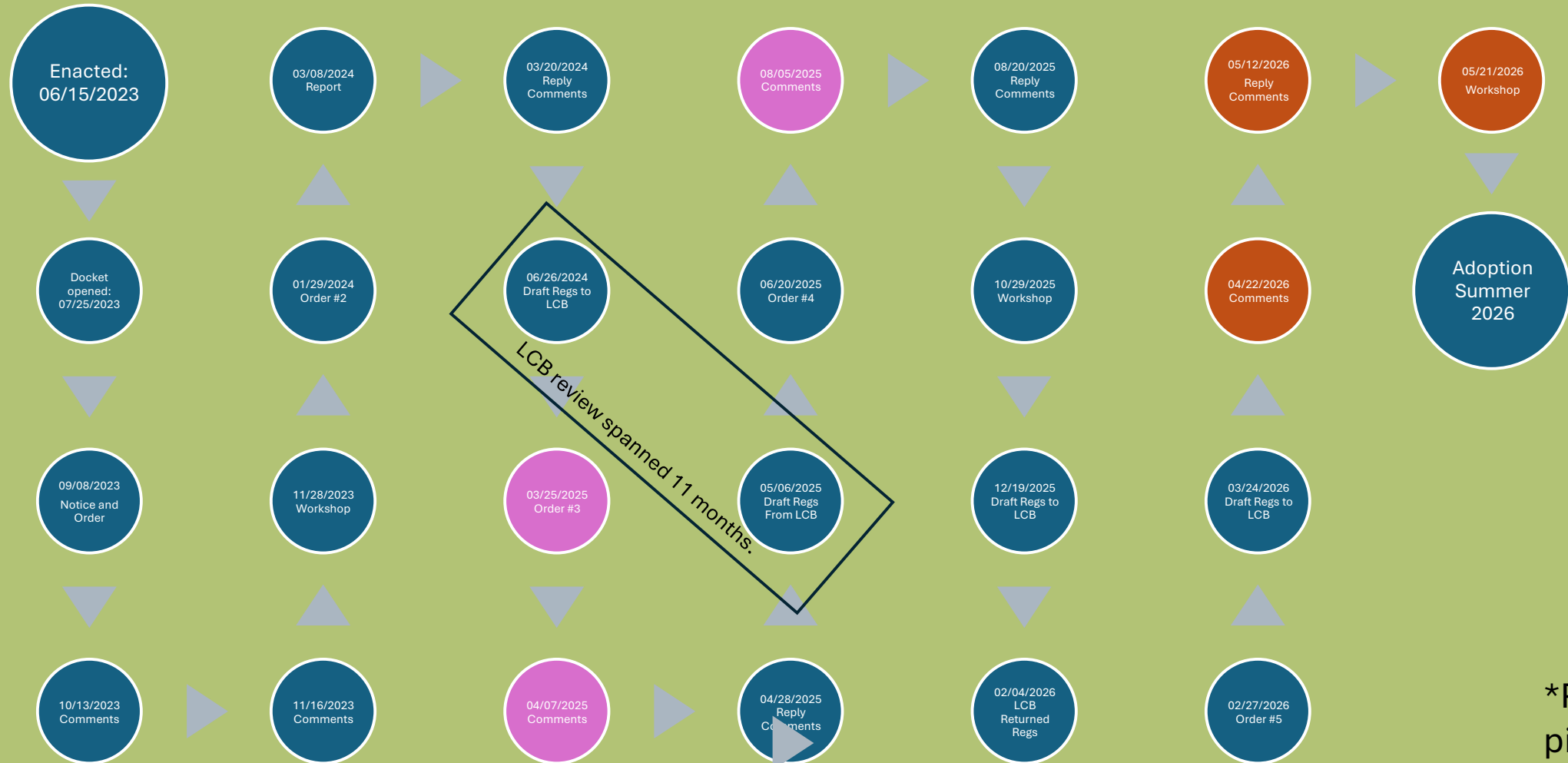
Docket No. 23-07025 – Timeline



Rulemakings from 82nd (2023) Legislative Session, cont.

- Docket No. 23-07026 - Rulemaking to amend, adopt, and/or repeal regulations in accordance with Assembly Bill 524 (2023).
 - Commenters: NV Energy, Tony Simmons, Caesars Enterprises, LLC, MGM Resorts International, Nevada Resort Association, Boyd Gaming Corp., Station Casinos LLC, Venetian Las Vegas Gaming, LLC, Western Resource Advocates, Google LLC, the Regulatory Operations Staff of the Commission, Interwest Energy Alliance, Nevada Workers for Clean and Affordable Energy, Advanced Energy United, Bureau of Consumer Protection, Walmart Inc., Solar Energy Industry Association, Wynn Las Vegas, LLC, and the Smart Energy Alliance.
 - Over 550 pages of comments
 - Two formal Commission-led workshops over 4 hours; multiple informal workshops.
 - NRS 233B workshop and hearing upcoming
 - Final regulation: 25 pages
 - Complexity: Intense, highly complex interactions with existing regulations and statutes, thorough engagement by stakeholders.

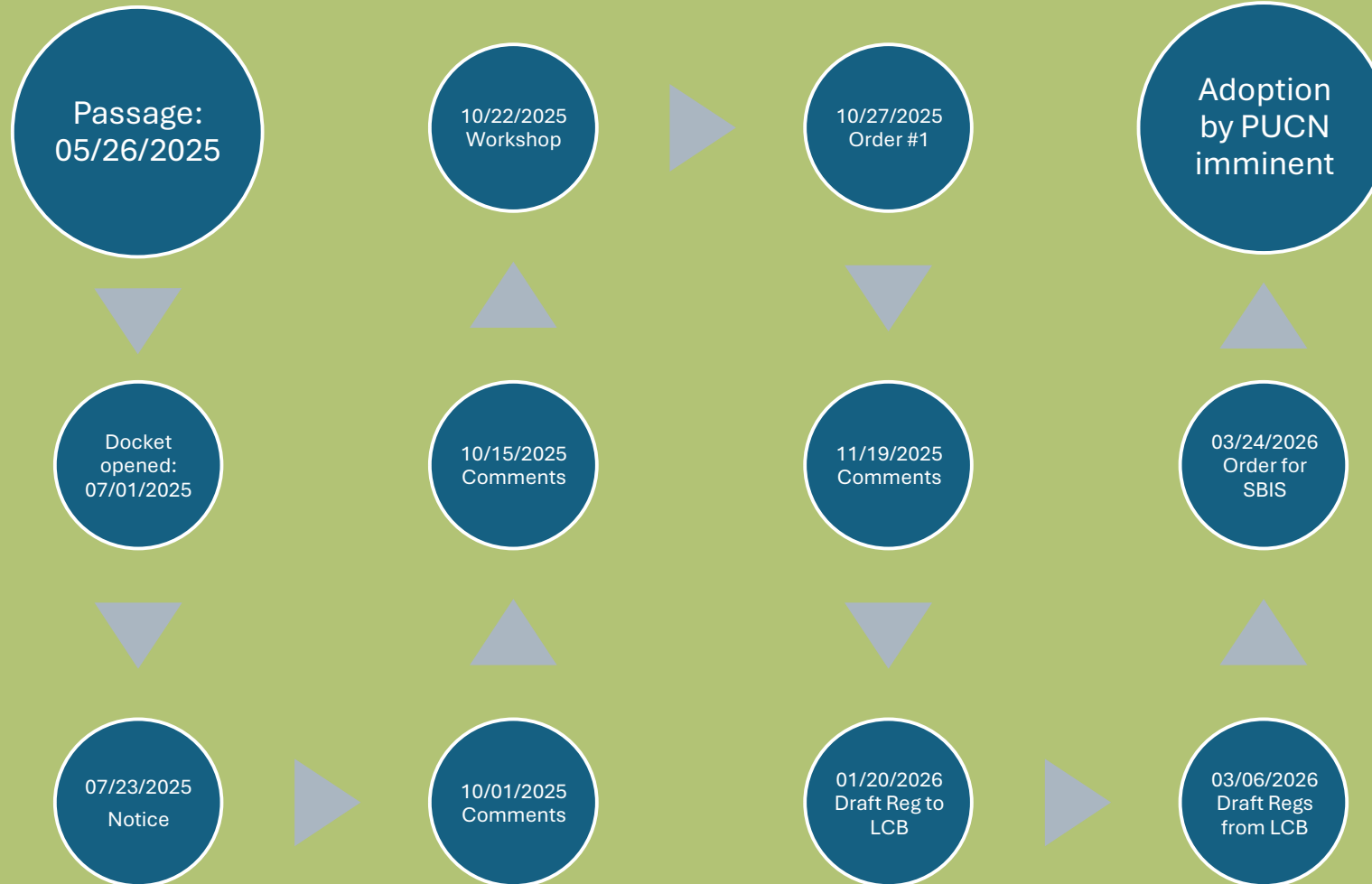

Rulemakings from 83rd (2025) Legislative Session

- Docket No. 25-07001 - Rulemaking to amend, adopt, and/or repeal regulations in accordance with Assembly Bill 46 (2025).
 - Commenters: Southwest Gas Corp., Regulatory Operations Staff of the Commission, NV Energy, Southern Nevada Gaming Group, Nevada Resort Assn., Western Resource Advocates, Constellation Energy Generation, LLC, and Tenaska Power Services Co., Beehive Telephone Company, Inc., Nevada E4 Connect, Inc., Lincoln County Telephone System, Inc., Moapa Valley Telephone Company, Rural Telephone Company, Bureau of Consumer Protection, and AT&T Nevada.
 - Over 153 pages of comments
 - One formal Commission-led workshop at 30 minutes.
 - NRS 233B workshop and hearing upcoming
 - Final regulation: 24 pages
 - Complexity: Relatively straightforward regulation, made more complicated by the wide-reaching effect they have on all regulated utilities, not just one sector.

- Docket No. 25-07002 - Rulemaking to amend, adopt, and/or repeal regulations in accordance with Assembly Bill 449 (2025).
 - Commenters:
 - Pahrump Utility Company, Inc., NV Energy, Regulatory Operations Staff of the Commission.
 - One formal Commission-led workshop.
 - NRS 233B workshop and hearing upcoming
 - Final regulation: 3 pages
 - Complexity: Relatively straightforward rulemaking; few comments; nearly complete.

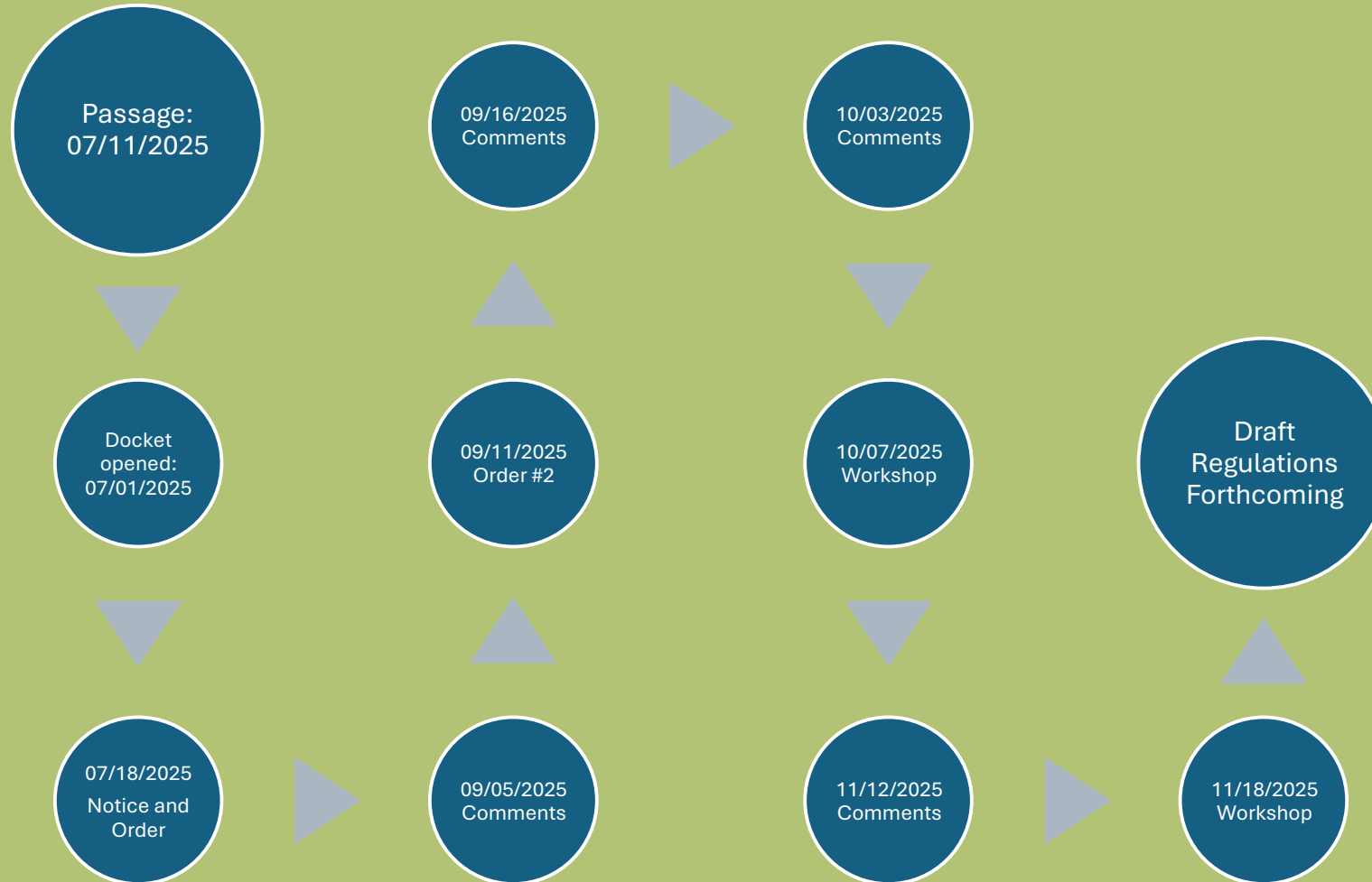
Docket No. 25-07002 – Timeline



Rulemakings from 83rd (2025) Legislative Session, cont.

- Docket No. 25-07003 - Investigation and Rulemaking to amend, adopt, and/or repeal regulations in accordance with Assembly Bill 452 (2025).
 - Commenters: Bureau of Consumer Protection, Western Resource Advocates, Caring Helping and Restoring Lives, Nevada Conservation League, Advanced Energy United, Regulatory Operations Staff of the Commission, Utility Watch Nevada, Southwest Gas Corp., Solar United Neighbors, Southwest Energy Efficiency Project, NV Energy, Faith in Action Nevada, Mormon Women for Ethical Government, Chispa Nevada, David Chairez, and Caleb Picker.
 - Over 400 pages of comments
 - Two formal Commission-led workshops over 5 hours.
 - Final regulation: TBD
 - Complexity: highly complex discussion and topic with numerous divergent viewpoints.

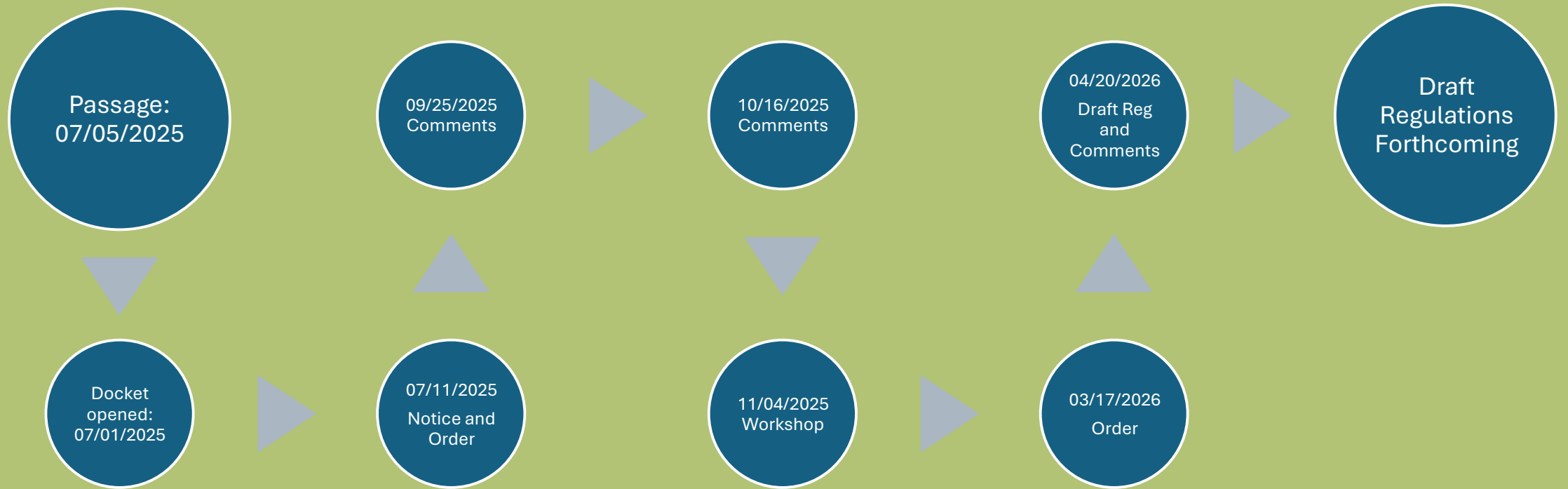
Docket No. 25-07003 – Timeline



Rulemakings from 83rd (2025) Legislative Session, cont.

- Docket No. 25-07004 - Rulemaking to amend, adopt, and/or repeal regulations in accordance with Assembly Bill 458 (2025).
 - Commenters: NV Energy, Regulatory Operations Staff of the Commission
 - Over 36 pages of comments
 - One formal Commission-led workshop one-half hour.
 - Draft regulation: 26 pages
 - Complexity: Challenging interactions with recently promulgated regulations; prescriptive statute.

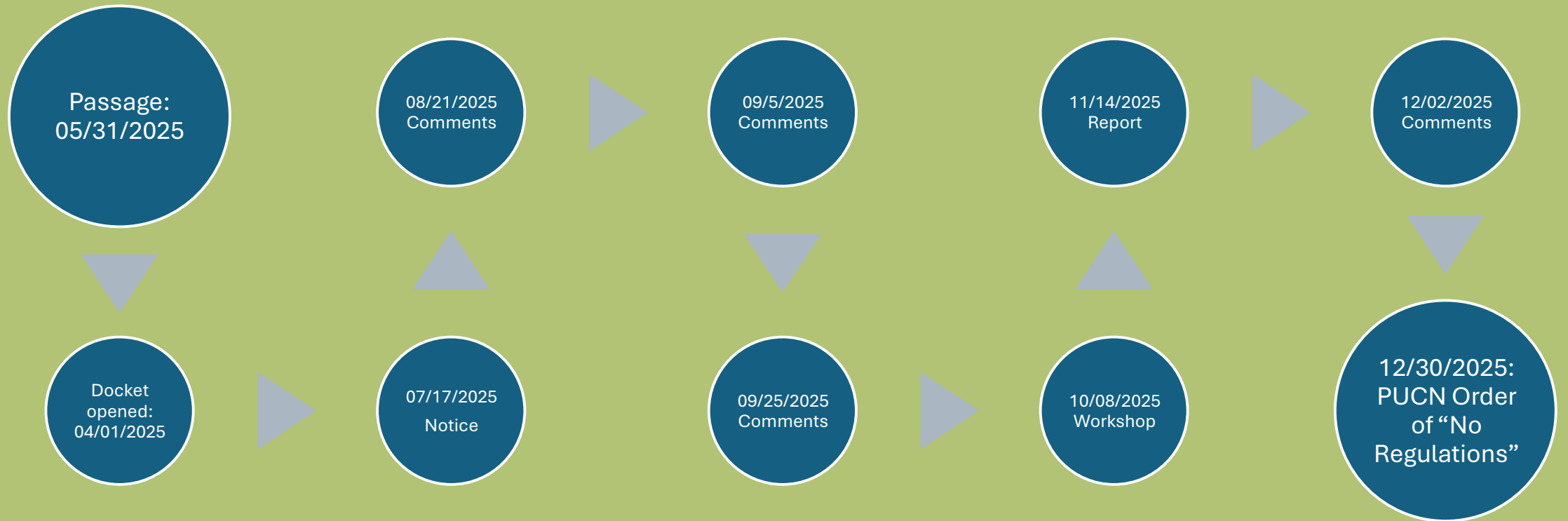
Docket No. 25-07004 – Timeline



Rulemakings from 83rd (2025) Legislative Session, cont.

- Docket No. 25-07005 - Rulemaking to amend, adopt, and/or repeal regulations in accordance with Senate Bill 326 (2025).
 - Commenters: Indian Springs Water Co., Diamond Indian Springs, LLC., Regulatory Operations Staff of the Commission.
 - Over 70 pages of comments
 - One formal Commission-led workshop of about an hour.
 - Final regulation: No regulations required
 - Complexity: Few affected utilities with few customers requires careful balancing.

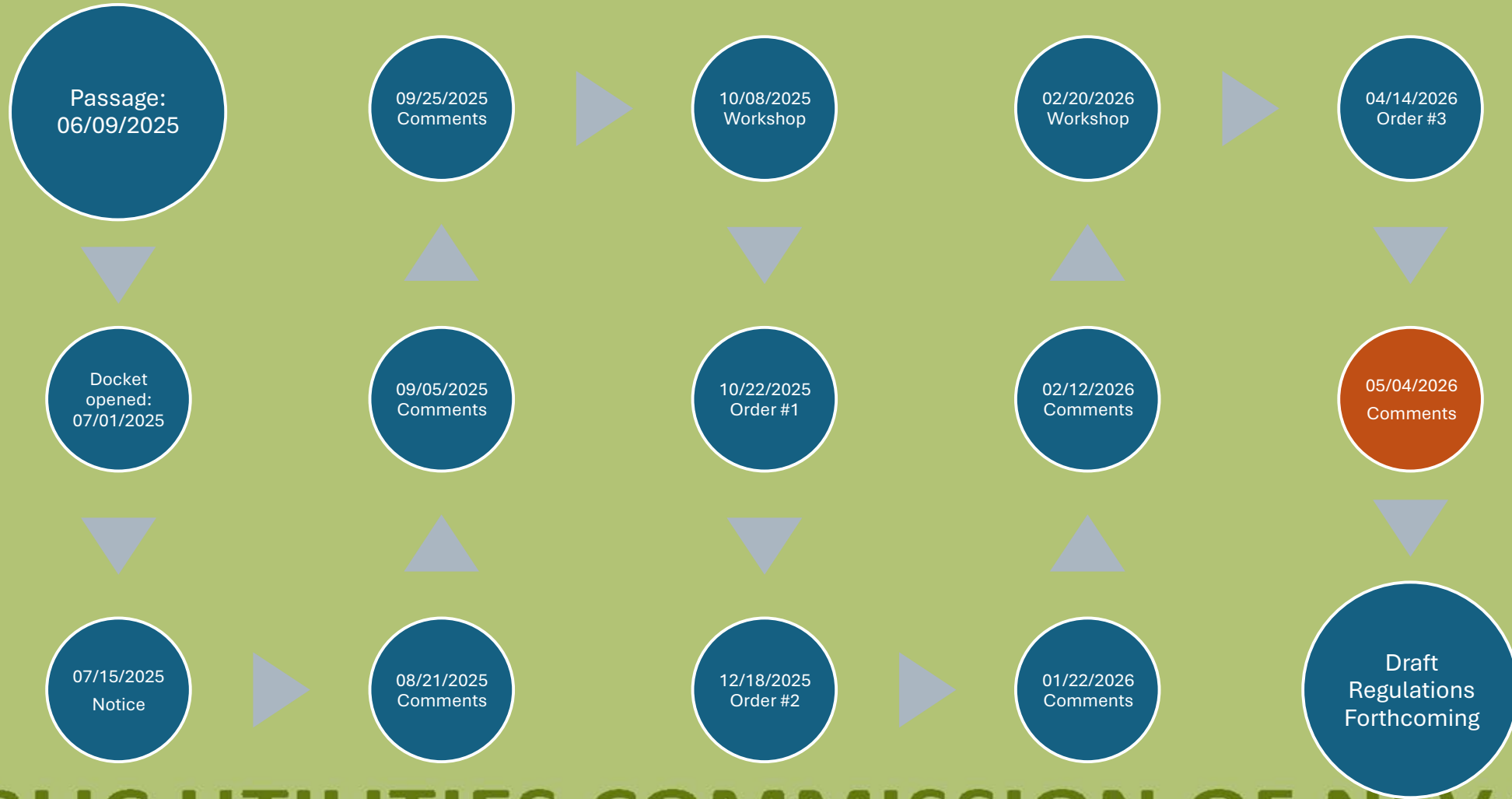

Rulemakings from 83rd (2025) Legislative Session, cont.

- Docket No. 25-07006 - Rulemaking to amend, adopt, and/or repeal regulations in accordance with Senate Bill 417 (2025).
 - Commenters: Bureau of Consumer Protection, Western Resource Advocates, Regulatory Operations Staff of the Commission, Southwest Gas Corp., Southwest Energy Efficiency Project, NV Energy, Boyd Gaming Corp., Station Casinos LLC, Venetian Las Vegas Gaming, LLC.
 - Over 260 pages of comments
 - Two formal Commission-led workshop for over 2 hours.
 - Draft regulation: 19 pages
 - Complexity: Intense, highly complex interactions with existing regulations and statutes, thorough engagement by stakeholders.

Rulemakings from 83rd (2025) Legislative Session, cont.

- Docket No. 25-07007 - Rulemaking to amend, adopt, and/or repeal regulations in accordance with Senate Bill 442 (2025).
 - Commenters: Bureau of Consumer Protection, Regulatory Operations Staff of the Commission, Southwest Gas Corp., Southwest Energy Efficiency Project, NV Energy, Chispa Nevada, Sierra Club, and CTIA – The Wireless Assn.
 - Over 46 pages of comments
 - One formal Commission-led workshop one hour.
 - Final regulation: TBD
 - Complexity: Relatively straightforward statute with high-level concerns about customer service needs.
