NEVADA SILVER HAIRED LEGISLATIVE FORUM

Nevada Revised Statutes 427A.320–427A.400



CREATION

The Nevada Silver Haired Legislative Forum (NSHLF) was created by the State Legislature in 1997.

PURPOSE

The purpose of the NSHLF is to identify and make recommendations on issues of importance to aging persons.

POWERS

The Forum holds public hearings and meetings, and it forms committees as necessary to conduct the business of the Forum.

The NSHLF submits a report containing recommendations for legislative action to the Legislative Commission and the Governor in each even-numbered year.

QUALIFICATIONS

A member of the NSHLF must:

- Have been a resident of Nevada for five years;
- Have been a registered voter in the Senatorial District for three years; and
- Be at least 60 years of age.

NOMINATIONS

Each State Senator shall, after consulting with the members of the Assembly who reside in his or her senatorial district, nominate a person who meets the requirements.

APPOINTMENT

The Legislative Commission shall appoint to the NSHLF a number of members equal to the number of State Senators.



EX OFFICIO MEMBERS

The members of Nevada's Delegation to the National Silver Haired Congress (NSHC) serve as ex officio members of the Forum.

PRIOR LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS

During the 76th Legislative Session, the Forum's No. 1 Recommendation, which was to create a Statewide Alert System for Older Persons, was passed. The 77th Legislative Session granted the Forum authority to submit one bill draft request every session.
