

SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATIONS

JOINT INTERIM STANDING COMMITTEE ON GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS

Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 218E.320

This summary presents the recommendations approved by the Joint Interim Standing Committee on Government Affairs at its meeting on August 27, 2026. The bill draft requests (BDRs) will be forwarded to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmittal to the 84th Session of the Nevada Legislature.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR LEGISLATION

Vehicles

1. Request the drafting of a bill to expand the trail connector distance described in [NRS 490.090](#) for off-highway vehicles from two to five miles. **(BDR –497)**
2. Request the drafting of a bill making various changes relating to derelict vehicles. **(BDR –506)**

Public Meetings

3. Request the drafting of a bill to revise provisions governing the public hearing process of the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada to improve public access. **(BDR –498)**

Unhoused

4. Request the drafting of a bill to define persons experiencing homelessness and to clarify protected rights of such persons. **(BDR –499)**

Law Enforcement

5. Request the drafting of a bill to implement the recommendations of the Purple Ribbon Task Force on Firefighter and Peace Officer Wellness relating to the well-being of public safety personnel. **(BDR –500)**
6. Request the drafting of a bill to require law enforcement agencies to submit standardized reports on enforcement activity occurring during special events and other large-scale events, including public demonstrations and protests, to the Nevada Legislature. **(BDR –501)**
7. Request the drafting of a bill to revise provisions relating to peace officer labor organizations, including topics such as collective bargaining, disciplinary procedures, and transparency in certain personnel matters. **(BDR –502)**

8. Request the drafting of a bill to address potential liability issues arising from memoranda of understanding between local law enforcement agencies and federal agencies relating to immigration enforcement. **(BDR –503)**

Artificial Intelligence

9. Request the drafting of a bill to establish standards for the use of artificial intelligence by state and local governmental entities, including requirements relating to transparency, accountability, and protections against bias in automated decision-making. **(BDR –504)**

Public Records

10. Request the drafting of a bill to implement the recommendations of the Public Records Task Force relating to the administration and enforcement of Nevada’s public records law. **(BDR –505)**
