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Regulation R074-13

My name is Adam Plain, I am the Insurance Regulation Liaison for the Nevada Division of Insurance, and I am here to present Regulation R074-13, concerning Exchange Enrollment Facilitators.

R074-13 is proposed to meet the requirements of Section 25 of Assembly Bill 425 of the 77th (2013) Session of the Nevada Legislature. The proposed regulation consists of 42 sections organized into five topics.

Sections 1-10 of the proposed regulation are administrative in nature, defining several terms used throughout the regulation and delineating the Commissioner's authority to contract with a third party to administer portions of the regulation.

Sections 11-19 of the proposed regulation outline the precertification education requirements of exchange enrollment facilitator ("EEF") applicants as well as the requirements for a course of precertification education to be approved by the Commissioner of Insurance.

Sections 20-22 of the proposed regulation detail the requirements for an EEF applicant who has passed the precertification course to sit the certification examination and receive their certification, including the requirement to submit fingerprints for a background check.

Sections 23-32 of the proposed regulation outline the continuing education requirements of certified EEFs as well as the requirements for a course of continuing education to be approved by the Commissioner of Insurance.

Sections 33-42 of the proposed regulation detail the duties owed by a certified EEF to the consumers they assist, including disclosure of any potential or perceived conflicts of interest.
