




What Are Other Resorts Doing?

- Single unified brand


Increasingly, resort visitors are simply expecting that they will not need a car to enjoy a well-rounded vacation experience

Other Resorts: Size of Transit Program (Annual Vehicle Service Hours)



Peer Average = 122,400 North Tahoe (37,900) is 31 % of Peer Average

Other Resorts: Annual Transit Ridership



Peer Average = 2.7M North Tahoe (0.45M) is 17 % of Peer Average


