RE: Unpaid debts of the Nevada Fire Safe Council for completed wildfire prevention projects.

Dear Sir or Madam:

The purpose of this memo is to describe the results of an effort lead by the Lake Tahoe Basin Chiefs to compile an accurate set of financial records for Nevada Fire Safe Council (NVFSC). This effort was undertaken in collaboration with the remaining Board of Directors of the NVFSC, creditors to the NVFSC, and with the bankruptcy estate trustees of the NVFSC. The purpose is to both understand what happened at the NVFSC and to facilitate the final resolution of the NVFSC's financial affairs.

Background

Staff from North Lake Tahoe Fire District and Tahoe Douglas Fire District created an MS Access database that is a repository of the paid and unpaid invoices from fuels reduction activities and is the reporting tool that is the source of the summary spreadsheets described in this document. The output of the database and process of creating the database enabled the fire districts to compile several reports that describe the relevant details of grant distributions to the NVFSC and then payments to contractors.

During this process it was confirmed that the NVFSC took money from Forest Service grants and paid some invoices for projects that were to be funded by BLM grants. Once the BLM and Forest Service determined that there was a "co-mingling of funds," all payments to the NVFSC were suspended. The following documents describe the financial irregularities of the NVFSC, corrective actions taken by the NVFSC and then the results of the compilation completed by the Lake Tahoe Basin Fire Chiefs.

Attachment A: Description of NVFSC Deficiencies and Corrective Actions

During the compilation of grant distributions to the NVFSC and payments to contractors, it became apparent that critical internal control and financial accounting deficiencies resulted in the financial problems noted in the OIG reports and ultimately led to the bankruptcy of the NVFSC. A description of those deficiencies and corrective actions is provided at Attachment A to this document.

Description of Summary Financial Reports

The NVFSC was awarded over \$21 million in federal grants over a five year period. And so there is a large volume of documents that substantiate the amounts paid or currently due. Also there is great deal of complexity because of the fact that the NVFSC operated using a single bank account for all grants and member contributions. Thus the challenge was to summarize the data into a comprehensible set of documents. The following documents summarize the financial data that was compiled:

Attachment B: Nevada Fire Safe Council Claim Register

The Nevada Fire Safe Council Claim Register is a complete list of the NVFSC creditors that filed claims with the U. S. Bankruptcy Court. This list is different from the total creditors list because some businesses and agencies did not file timely claims with the Court.

Attachment C: NVFSC Grant Summary

This spreadsheet shows all of the grants that were awarded to the NVFSC, how much has been drawn on each grant, and the total costs incurred working on the grant. The worksheet titled 'Amount Due from Grants' shows what should be paid from the respective grants to cover costs incurred working on the projects approved in the original grant applications. The second worksheet titled 'Amount Owed by NVFSC' has an Unpaid Costs column that represents amounts due to the contractors who worked on the projects. At Row 24, SNPLMA 9 Carson, Column G shows that there is \$239,220.18 in unpaid costs, but in fact this grant owes the entire \$1 million and the net of \$760,779.82 was paid to contractors from money drawn from Forest Service grants or even other SNPLMA grants. The net is from invoices from one grant being used to obtain money from an entirely different grant.

Attachment D: NVFSC Comprehensive Unpaid Summary

This attachment contains a summary of all invoices submitted to the Nevada Fire Safe Council that remain unpaid. It does not contain information on invoices paid with "co-mingled" funds, therefore it does not represent the amount owed by federal agencies to NVFSC, but the amount owed by NVFSC to creditors. This spreadsheet introduces the concept of "tainted" and "untainted" invoices. A "tainted" invoice is an invoice that was used for a grant draw, but the contractor was not paid. That case is in Column B. An "untainted" invoice is an invoice that was not used for a grant draw, and the contractor is unpaid. That case is in Column C. Now the interesting part about Column B, is that that money went to someone. Where the money went is not shown on this spreadsheet, but we know what invoices have been paid where the authorizing grant has never paid a distribution. As an example, Tahoe Douglas Fire District has been paid for work done on land between Lake Tahoe and Carson City, but there has never been a distribution from the grant that authorized that work. It turns out the money the fire district was paid came from a grant from the California side of the Lake Tahoe Basin.

Attachment E: NVFSC Grant Flowchart

This attachment shows the likely flow of cash to and from the NVFSC from all of the grants. The important point about this flowchart is that it is not exact because money is fungible. But it is a convenient explanation of how the money was used and distributed through the NVFSC. On this flowchart look at the top left and the SNPLMA Carson 9 grant. In this case, work was done that was approved in the grant, \$844,829.36 was paid to contractors working on these projects. \$432,831.48 came from USFSO9, \$343,699.08 came from USFS ARRA funds, and \$68,298.80 came from other SNPLMA grants. Now there are unpaid costs associated with this grant of \$239,220.18. The BLM owes both the \$844,829.36 and \$239,220.18. So no money has ever been paid by BLM for projects originally authorized by this grant.

Attachment F: MS PowerPoint Slides Showing Simplified Cash Flows

The MS PowerPoint presentation attached to this document shows a simplified scenario for how funds both appropriately and inappropriately distributed by the NVFSC. In 2008 when the NVFSC first began managing SNPLMA Round 8 funds, projects were paid from the appropriate grants in a timely manner. It is not known exactly when the NVFSC executive director began paying bills with funds from unrelated grants, however it is known that bills from SNPLMA Round 9 Carson Range grant and SNPLMA Round 10 Spring Mountain grant were paid from funds obtained from US Forest Service grants for the Lake Tahoe Basin. Those unauthorized payments, when discovered by the BLM, forced the BLM to put the NVFSC on agency review and ultimately led to the suspension of all reimbursements to the NVFSC.

Conclusion

It is now clear that there were serious financial irregularities at the NVFSC and that federal, state and local agencies were materially harmed by the failure to implement proper internal controls for grant payments. The end result is that several million dollars are owed to contractors who completed good projects on good faith that they would be paid. Several of these contractors have gone bankrupt and many jobs have been lost at no fault of their own. The Lake Tahoe Basin Chiefs respectfully request that the BLM and Forest Service work together to finally get these past due invoices paid for work that was already completed.

RE: Nevada Fire Safe Council financial deficiencies identified and resolutions

In 2011 the BLM and U.S. Forest Service discovered accounting irregularities at the NVFSC. The findings were significant enough that all grant funding had to be suspended until the full extent of the problem was identified and corrective actions were taken. Since then the following deficiencies were noted and corrective actions were taken:

- 1) Grant assistance agreements were missing
- 2) Federal audits were missing for four years
- 3) Indirect cost rate calculations and applications were missing.
- 4) Accounting of grant funds was incomplete and inaccurate.

The irregularities were significant and did require that the federal agencies suspend payments until corrective actions were taken. The following corrective actions have been taken:

- 1) All missing grant assistance agreements were completed and signed by BLM.
- 2) Federal single audits were completed and audits of compliance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles were also completed.
- 3) Indirect cost rate applications were completed and submitted.
- 4) A database was created to organize all of the expenses relating to grant funding of fuels reduction projects was created. This database is a repository of all of the grant expenditures, both paid and unpaid, for the NVFSC. We now know what was spent, what it was spent for, and whether the bill was paid. We also have backup documentation for the expenditures so that the federal agencies can audit the expenditures and determine if the expenses are allowable.
 - a. The U.S. Forest Service has also audited the details of outstanding balances related to their grants and determined which costs are allowable.

At this point, all of the significant deficiencies noted above have been corrected and competent data has been produced that should facilitate payment to fuels reduction contractors.


