 - Amendment would provide the superintendent of schools the discretion to allow a modification to the expulsion requirement for:
 - Battery
 - > Sale or distribution of controlled substance
 - > Status as a habitual disciplinary problem

^{*}Current statute allows for the discretion if a student is found in possession of a firearm or dangerous weapon.
