
Sector: Energy, Manufacturing & Mining

- Facilitated the implementation of the Right Skills Now program to train computer numerical controlled (CNC) system operators in partnership with WNC and Dream It Do It Nevada




Sector: Healthcare

- Partners include Renown Health, St. Mary's, Northern Nevada Medical Center and a host of other providers






Job Prep – Outside Classroom
