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Kirstin Lobato has spent over 10 years in prison wrongfully convicted. She has tried to have DNA from the crime scene tested using current technology not available at the time of her trial, but the motion was denied by the District court, and the current statute does not allow an appeal to a higher court. There would be NO COST to the state or the taxpayers of Nevada as the Innocence Project in NY has committed to paying for the testing.

The evidence consists of 13 pieces of evidence that would have been touched by the real perpetrator, not a pile of trash as the DA's opposing brief would have you believe, or the DA's office reported to the media. The items include semen found in the rectum of the victim which was not placed there by Kirstin Lobato. Over 146,000 people across the world have signed a petition to DA Wolfson to allow the testing. What does he have to lose? Why is the DA's office opposing it?

This young woman deserves a chance to prove her innocence by current scientific methods. The DA's job is supposed to be serving justice. How is justice served if an innocent person is imprisoned for a crime they didn't commit and the real perpetrator is allowed to escape justice while the DA's office fights their efforts to prove the truth?

It is time to correct our DNA statute to allow those who claim innocence to prove it by scientific methods. It is a waste of taxpayer dollars as well as State resources to continue to incarcerate innocent people.

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
