

# Streaming of Legislative Hearings to Mobile Devices using Granicus Software

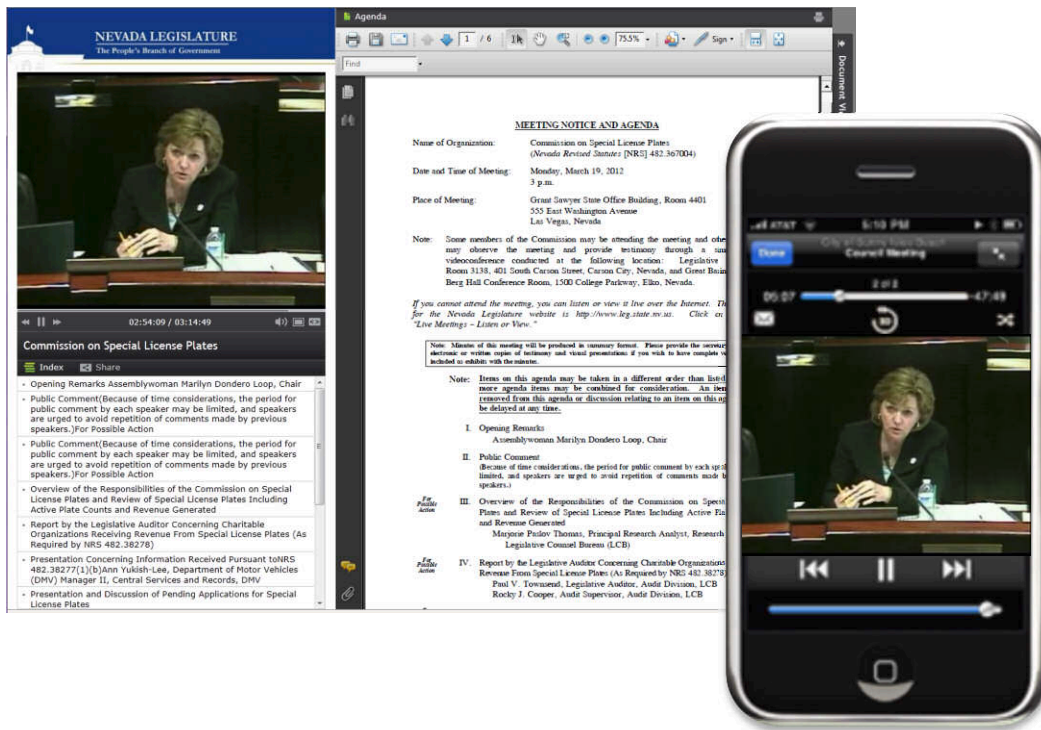
The Granicus mobile streaming product has been approved for implementation for this upcoming session. This will only impact the way streaming and archiving of the video for meetings is done. The process of logging and transcribing meeting information, which is performed by the session secretaries, will remain the same as they will continue using the FTR audio product.

Some of the new features of the new Granicus product include:

- Live video on mobile devices and tablets including iPhones, iPads, and Androids.
- Archived video for Legislators and Staff.
- Search feature for archived video.
- View archived video in native format (additional FTR player software not needed).

## Live Video with Mobile Device

The live meetings will be viewable on multiple platforms, including the iPad, iPhone, Android phones and tablets, or other devices that support Flash, HTML5 and Silverlight.



## Archived Video for Legislators and Staff

The page for the archived meetings shows upcoming events as well as archived video, which would only be visible to Legislators and Staff from our internal network or via a VPN connection.


