BULLYING/CYBER-BULLYING

 2010-2011 school year: 188 calls for service. 57 of those calls for service resulted in criminal action being taken by law enforcement.

INCIDENTS THAT INVOLVED BULLYING/CYBER-BULLYING

A female 6th grade middle school student was being bullied by a male student. Repeated name calling consisting of "slut, bitch, dumb, jackass, horn ball, stupid bitch, meanie". Male student would repeatedly elbow, grab her hair and "air hump" the female student. The male student told the girl that he wanted her to perform sexual favors on him after the school day ended.

INCIDENTS THAT INVOLVED BULLYING/CYBER-BULLYING

A female 16 year old high school student had photos taken off of her Facebook page by another 16 year old female student. The photos were copied and pasted on the website thedirty.com where false statements were made about the victim's sexual activities and the site was accessed by other students.

INCIDENTS THAT INVOLVED BULLYING/CYBER-BULLYING

> A female 8th grade middle school student was repeatedly called "ugly and fat" by classmates. During a bus ride home, she gave her friend a note that said, "I am killing myself tonight." Once the friend informed authorities, the female student was taken for a medical evaluation due to the context of the note and multiple self-inflicted burns to her hands and cuts to her forearm which were noticed by responding officers.

SEXTING CASE

Two female middle school students were at a birthday party and took/sent nude photographs of themselves from their cellular phones. One of the male middle school students befriended the girls at the party. The girls sent the nude photos to the male student, who later had his phone taken away because his mother could no longer afford it. The phone was given to an adult male who was friends with the male students father. The photos remained on the phone and the adult male posed as a high school student and text the girls who sent the nude photos. The females kept talking to the man and he then threatened that if they did not send more nude photos, then he would put the photos he had of them on-line.

INTERVENTIONS

- Conducting conflict resolutions with involved parties by mutual agreement in no bullying cases.
 - Intervention classes and private counseling for victims and those with alleged behaviors- MFT and UNR assistance
 - Counselor involvement and parental contact with both the victim(s) and suspect(s) involved.
 - Presentations done by officers, counselors and community members.
 - Follow-up with victims of the bullying.


