

# Program Highlights

- ▶ Lander, White Pine, Humboldt and Pershing County Schools have agreements to:
    - Educate students from neighboring counties that are near county borders.
    - Share professional development to minimize costs of training.
    - Share human resources such as school psychologists, occupational therapists, and school nurses.
    - Work together on transportation and maintenance programs (including energy retrofitting).

# Cooperation with Local Government

- ▶ Lyon and Storey County School Districts are in discussions to consolidate some services and equipment with local government agencies to reduce costs.
- ▶ Elko County School District is in discussions with the Elko County Sheriff's Office to:
  - provide hot meals to the County Jail through the District kitchens and
  - allow law enforcement to fuel vehicles at District transportation yardsin order to trade costs of school resource officers.

# Suggested NRS Changes

- ▶ NRS 244.1505 and NRS 332.185 allow donation of surplus property. A proposed change would be to reword both statutes to allow school districts to donate surplus property to each other.
