Program Highlights

- Lander, White Pine, Humboldt and Pershing County Schools have agreements to:
 - Educate students from neighboring counties that are near county borders.
 - Share professional development to minimize costs of training.
 - Share human resources such as school psychologists, occupational therapists, and school nurses.
 - Work together on transportation and maintenance programs (including energy retrofitting).

Cooperation with Local Government

- Lyon and Storey County School Districts are in discussions to consolidate some services and equipment with local government agencies to reduce costs.
- Elko County School District is in discussions with the Elko County Sheriff's Office to:
 - provide hot meals to the County Jail through the District kitchens and
 - allow law enforcement to fuel vehicles at District transportation yards

in order to trade costs of school resource officers.

Suggested NRS Changes

NRS 244.1505 and NRS 332.185 allow donation of surplus property. A proposed change would be to reword both statutes to allow school districts to donate surplus property to each other.
