- Document into report prototypes


(BRIEF) PROJECT BACKGROUND

Determine Nevada's Feasibility and Plan to:



PROJECT GOALS

Determine Nevada's Feasibility and Plan to:

2. Administer a common, statewide Kindergarten entry assessment that generates data which educators are trained to use in order to improve program outcomes for children.



PROJECT APPROACH

- I. Build upon the planning included in the RTT-ELC application
- 2. Coordinate at both the state and local level with a variety of key stakeholders
- 3. Utilize a parallel, integrated planning process
- 4. Link to School Districts and ECE providers at the county level
- 5. Create a statewide plan with local implementation plans

PROJECT APPROACH

- Focus groups will be held in ALL counties of the state.
 Nevada's tribes will also be invited and engaged
- Additional data collection activities including key informant interviews and surveys will ensure that stakeholders are engaged at both the state and local level
- Input will be sought from parents, early childhood educators, local and state program administrators, school teachers and administrators, and other stakeholders

IMPORTANT MILESTONES

June **Deliverable** completion of 17 county specific Needs Assessment reports

August **Deliverable** of delivery of Phase 1 project knowledgebase with all reports and data including statewide plans
