The final meeting of Nevada's Legislative Committee on High-Level Radioactive Waste for the 2011-2012 Legislative Interim will be held on Friday, July 13, 2012, in Las Vegas, Nevada. As in previous interims, Committee staff will be reviewing all meeting materials and testimony received at the prior meeting and developing a list of recommendations for possible consideration by the Committee during the work session phase of its final meeting.
