



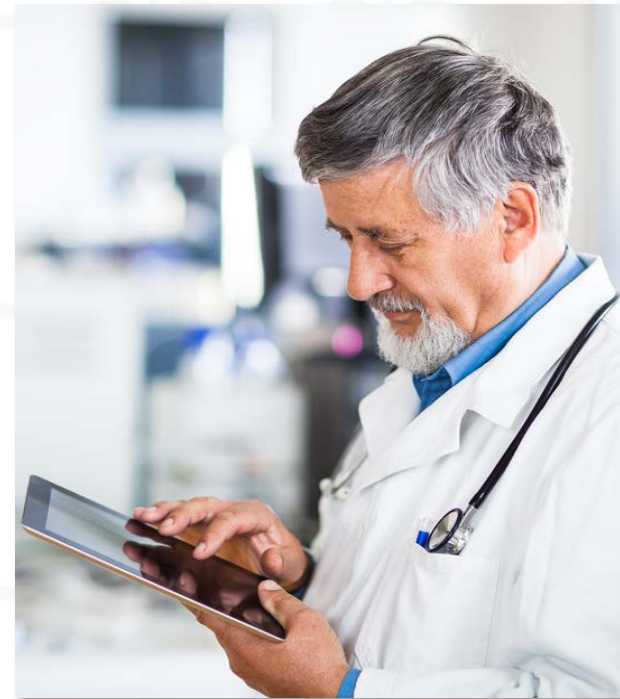

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Our Vision

To develop a world-class center for education, patient care, and research that prepares Nevada's doctors with the most innovative and technologically advanced forms of medical training while serving the health care needs of a diverse and urban population through community partnerships.



Educational Mission Starts

- + Oct. 18, 2016: Granted preliminary accreditation to accept first class
- + More than 900 applications received; 400 from Nevada or with ties to Nevada
- + 60 students to be selected for class to start July 17, 2017



UNLV Medicine Ackerman Autism Center



- Opened 7-1-16
- Partnership has allowed us to diagnose more than 300 children so far
- Comprehensive care, plus with early intervention for young patients
- Provide diagnostic, treatment, behavioral, social and transitional services

Clinical /Education Mission

+ UNLV Medicine clinical/educational practice opens 7-1-17 to teach while taking care of patients:

- UNLV will employ over 150 teaching faculty and 50 classified and administrative staff
- Practice to employ 300 nurses, medical assistants, therapists, social workers, front desk staff, etc., in teaching clinics
- UNLV faculty to supervise 279 residents and fellows at UMC, Sunrise, and the VA
- By July, 2017, will be over 800 total employees
