



# **Senate Bill 305**

**Industrial Cannabis Farming**

- *Authorizes* the cultivation, storage & sale of industrial cannabis, otherwise known as “industrial hemp” in Nevada.



- Perfect for rural Nevada in a time of need for water
- Uses 1/3 of the water as alfalfa



# Agriculture Act

- **Signed into law by the President Feb 7, 2014**
  - **Authorizing institutions of higher education and state departments of agriculture to cultivate industrial hemp for research purposes under an agriculture pilot program or for other academic or agricultural research.**



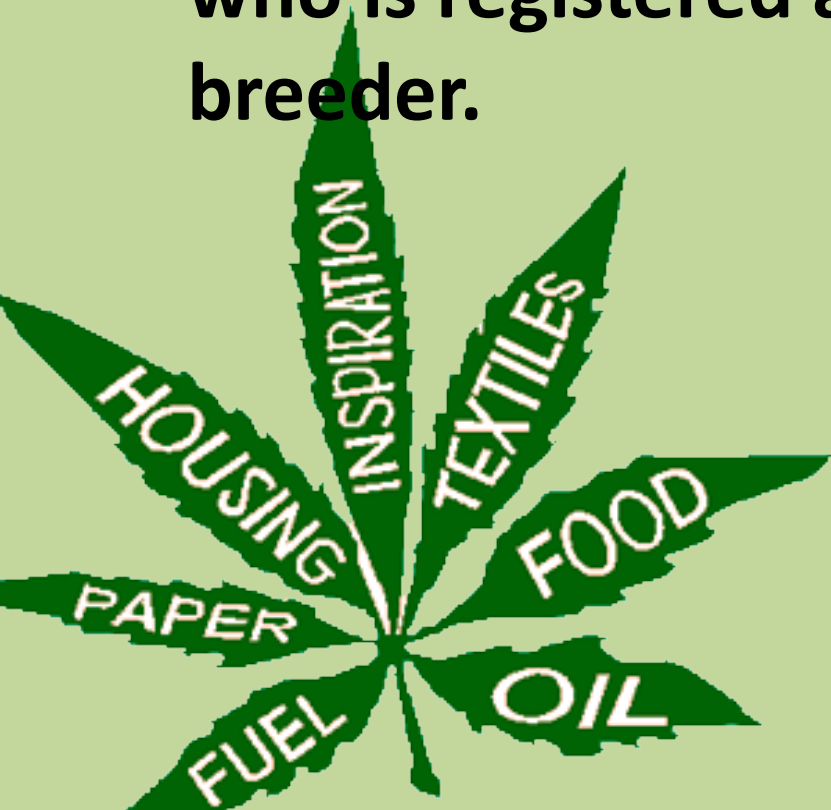
# Industrial Cannabis

A crop limited to non-psychoactive types of the plant *Cannabis sativa* L. with not more than 0.3% THC contained in the dried flowering tops, cultivated and processed exclusively for specified purpose



# SB 305

- Expressly prohibits the cultivation of industrial cannabis except by an established agricultural research institution or a person who is registered as a grower or a seed breeder.



# SB 305

- Authorizes the purchase and storage of industrial cannabis and the manufacturing and sale of products made from industrial cannabis by a registered producer.



# SB 305

- Establishes provisions for registration of growers, seed breeders, and producers
- Authorizes the State Board of Agriculture to establish registration and renewal fees.





# SB 305

- **Limits varieties of industrial cannabis to:**
  - those appearing on a Department of Agriculture approved list
  - those cultivated by an established agricultural research institution, or
  - a seed breeder in the process of developing a new seed cultivar.



# SB 305

- Establishes requirements for cultivation of industrial cannabis and testing of THC concentration.
- Authorizes a person to hold an ownership interest in both an entity registered for industrial cannabis and a medical marijuana establishment



# SB 305

- . . . but prohibits an entity from being registered for both industrial cannabis and as a medical marijuana establishment.

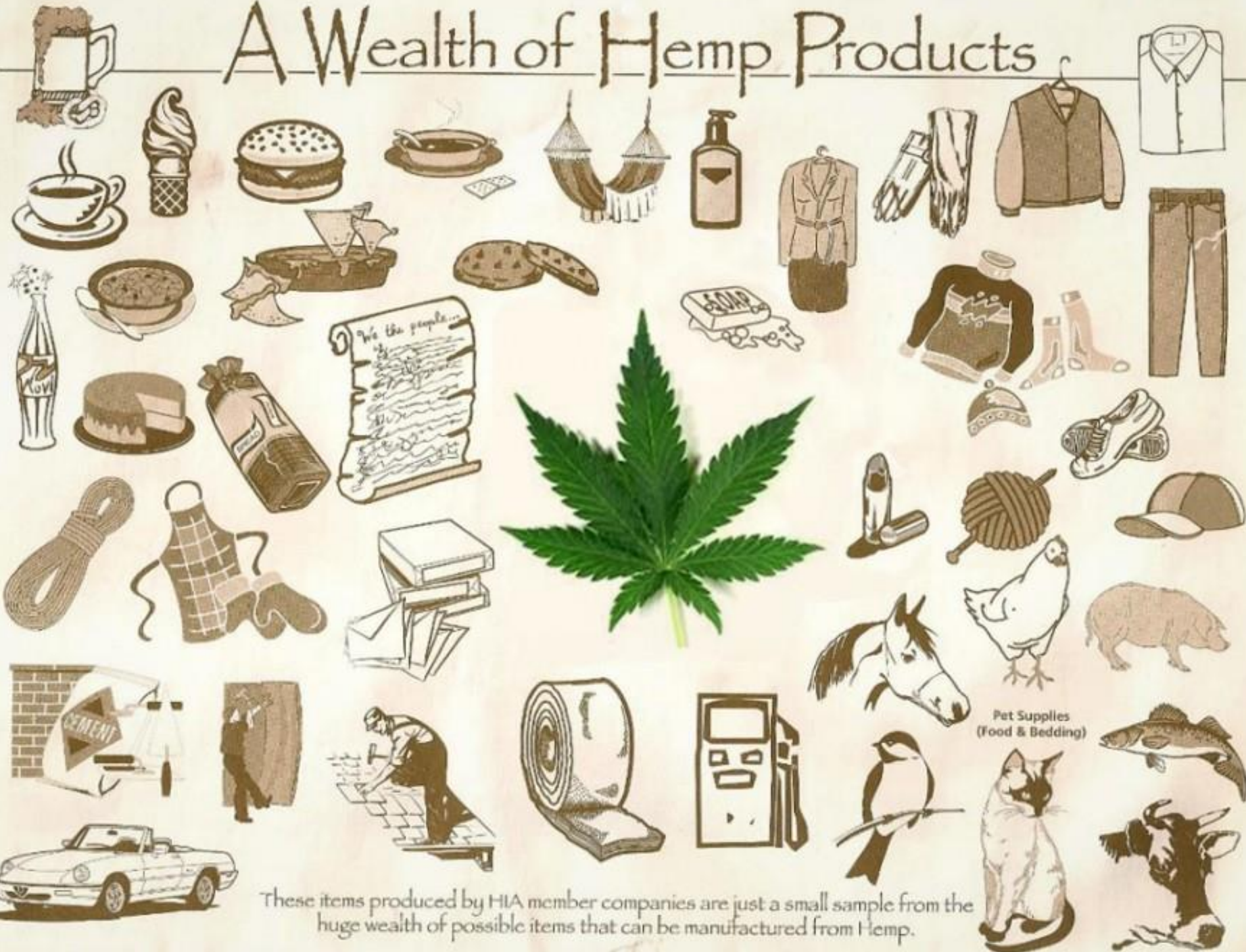


# SB 305

- Establishes the Industrial Cannabis Advisory Board.
- Excludes industrial cannabis from certain crimes relating to marijuana.
