ASSEMBLY BILL 150

Revises provisions governing the Governor Guinn Millennium Scholarship Program (BDR No. 34-200)

Sponsored by: Assembly members Stewart, Carrillo, Flores, and Nelson

Date Heard: April 16, 2015

**Fiscal Impact: Effect on Local Government: No.
Effect on the State: Yes.**

Assembly Bill 150 extends student eligibility for the Governor Guinn Millennium Scholarship to students who do not meet the minimum high school grade point average requirement but who receive a test score on a college entrance examination that meets the approved minimum score established by the Board of Regents of the University of Nevada.

Amendments: Working with the sponsor, Chair Harris has proposed the bill be clarified to require the applicable entrance exam be taken by the student while enrolled in high school.
