ASSEMBLY BILL 423

Provides for a study on transportation infrastructure and funding. (BDR S-1074)

Sponsored by: Committee on Transportation
Date Heard: April 30, 2015
Fiscal Impact: Effect on Local Government: No.
Effect on the State: Yes.

Assembly Bill 423 proposes to establish the Legislative Committee on Transportation Infrastructure and Funding to consist of six members appointed by legislative leadership. The Legislative Commission shall designate the chair and vice chair, whose two-year terms commence on July 1 of odd-numbered years. These offices must alternate between the two houses each biennium.

The committee shall review transportation projects and infrastructure, including revenue sources and funding options. Prior to each biennial session, the committee shall submit to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau (LCB) a report on its activities, findings, and recommendations. Any recommendations for legislation must be approved by a majority of the committee members from each house. Administrative and research support shall be provided by LCB.

The act becomes effective on July 1, 2015.
