Senate Bill 503 Overview

Goal:

Increase breakfast participation by requiring all schools that have 70 percent or greater free and reduced price eligible students to serve breakfast after the bell.

- Districts implementing Breakfast After the Bell will be eligible to apply for state appropriated start-up grants totaling \$2,000,000 over the biennium for start-up costs.
- Schools already implementing Breakfast After the Bell would not be eligible for start-up grants.
- There are a total of 123 eligible schools



Senate Bill 503 Overview

School Breakfast Start-up Grant funds can be used:

- To purchase equipment
- To market the Breakfast After the Bell program
- To increase current staff member hours

NDA will provide:

- Technical assistance
- Professional development
