

Proposed Conceptual Amendment for A.B. 138

Revise the bill to allow a person who has been convicted of a felony drug offense to be eligible for Temporary Assistance for Needy Families and Supplemental Nutrition Assistance benefits in this State, regardless of whether the person demonstrates he or she: (1) is participating in or has successfully completed a treatment program; (2) has not possessed, used or distributed controlled substances since beginning any such treatment program; or (3) is pregnant.
