Re: Support for Senate Bill 50

Committee Chair and members of the committee. We are writing in support of SB50 and encourage this committee to pass this bill. No knock warrants are some of the most dangerous warrant services for the members of law enforcement as well as the subjects the warrants are being served on. These warrants should rightfully be limited in scope and require enhanced level of scrutiny to obtain approval from the courts. The removal of the exclusionary rule from the original amended language was the correct course of action. This law should not expand the possibility for the loss of evidence when a warrant is legally obtained within the confines of the 4th Amendment of the US Constitution but is later found to fail to meet a portion of this new law. Based on the updated amended language drafted by the multitude of stakeholders on this bill we are in support.
