**SENATE BILL 4**

**Revises provisions governing certain programs to pay for prescription drugs, pharmaceutical services, and other benefits. (BDR 40-220)**

Senate Bill 4 revises provisions governing certain programs to pay for prescription drugs, pharmaceutical services, and other benefits. The bill authorizes the Department of Health and Human Services to allocate money into contracts or intergovernmental agreements to cover the cost of prescription drugs and pharmaceutical services for those who meet the criteria for eligibility and are residents of Nevada. Additionally, this bill expands the eligibility criteria, replacing the language of senior citizens and persons with disabilities with natural persons who are residents of this State.
