

Good Afternoon.

We are in opposition of AB 330 as it is written.

Where will the expelled children go?

The bill does not speak to the implementation of social emotional or mental health services in alternative schools. The bill does not clearly define "removal" of students. The bill does not clearly define "habitual" offenses in the quantity of occurrences. The bill has no mention of restorative interventions or supports that were mentioned during the testimony. The bill does not have language to say it is specifically for Tier 3 offenses on the MTSS.

The bill has a requirement for data to be reported to the state department of education; however that is already happening. The overall student discipline numbers for CCSD reflect disproportionate suspensions and expulsions of black and brown children. There is no mention of what accountability looks like for the school district's failure to reduce the amount of student discipline referrals. There is no language that speaks to the support for behavior schools which will receive the influx of students who will be referred to as a result of this bill.
