SENATE BILL 330

Revises provisions related to health care. (BDR 57-161)

Senate Bill 330 revises existing provisions requiring certain health insurance policies to provide coverage for mammograms to require such policies to additionally provide coverage to for imaging tests to screen for breast cancer and diagnostic imaging tests for breast cancer for certain covered persons without requiring any deductible, copayment, coinsurance, or any other form of cost-sharing. A health insurance policy issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2024, must include the required coverage imposed by this measure and any provisions of the policy that conflicts is void.
