To Members of the Committee:

We are writing on behalf of the Henderson Chamber of Commerce (HCC) and our over 1,800 members to express our opposition to AB312.

AB 312 creates the Commission on Environmental Justice that dictates what an agency must do to determine if a proposed regulation will have an environmental impact in underserved communities. This broad language has the potential to create more red tape for economic development in Nevada, stifling our growing economy and leading to an unfriendly business environment. In addition, the bill does not take into consideration the impact these regulations may have on small business, which is a primary driver of our economy. For these reasons, HCC is opposed to AB312.
