*SB394*

*Please OPPOSE SB394. The current property tax for schools is already at 75 cents per hundred. This added 10 cents per hundred will raise the property tax above the 3% property tax cap; hence it violates the Nevada tax cap statute. Our schools are failing in academic standards.
