SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 7 (R1)

Proposes to amend the Nevada Constitution to establish certain rights relating to reproductive health. (BDR C-864)

Sponsored By: Senators Cannizzaro, Lange, Scheible, Spearman, and Nguyen and Assembly Members Jauregui, Cohen, Backus, Marzola, and Gorelow, et al.

Senate Joint Resolution 7 proposes to amend the *Nevada Constitution* to: (1) establish a fundamental right to reproductive freedom; (2) authorize the State to regulate abortion care after fetal viability; and (3) prevent the State from penalizing, prosecuting, or taking any other adverse action against an individual based on the outcome of a pregnancy, a provider of health care under certain circumstances related to reproductive freedom, or an individual or entity for aiding or assisting another individual in exercising the individual's right to reproductive freedom.

Amendments: There are no amendments for this measure.

Special Note: If this resolution is passed by the 2023 Legislature, it must also be passed in identical form by the next Legislature and then approved and ratified by voters in an election before the proposed amendments to the *Nevada Constitution* become effective.
