In re: Support of SB 330:

The Nevada Chronic Care Collaborative (NCCC) is an alliance of non-profit health organizations, physician, provider, and consumer organizations united to improve the health of Nevadans. Collectively, our Collaborative represents over 1 million Nevadans with chronic conditions and diseases. NCCC encourages the development of healthcare policies focused on prevention and wellness and, accordingly, supports SB 330's removal of a financial barrier to many Nevadans who currently are unable to benefit from advances in breast cancer screening.
