ASSEMBLY BILL 24 (R1)

**Revises the membership of the Committee on Emergency Medical Services.
(BDR 40-222)**

Assembly Bill 24 adds two members to the Committee on Emergency Medical Services. One member shall be employed by or serve as a volunteer with a local governmental agency that provides emergency medical services, but which is not a part of a fire-fighting agency or law-enforcement agency. The other member shall be employed by or volunteer with an agency, organization, or other operator that provides emergency medical services on tribal land.
