**ASSEMBLY BILL 410 (R1)**

**Revises provisions relating to industrial insurance. (BDR 53-1030)**

**Sponsored By:** Assembly Members Jauregui, Yeager, O'Neill, and Monroe-Moreno

CONTAINS UNFUNDED MANDATE

Assembly Bill 410 expands the stress-related injuries that may be compensable under industrial insurance, in certain circumstances, to include a mental injury afflicting a first responder that is caused by extreme stress for which the primary cause was witnessing a series of specified events that arose out of and during the course of employment.

**Amendments:**

Assemblywoman Jauregui proposes the following amendments:

1. Add Senators Pazina, Spearman, and Stone as co-sponsors to the bill.

**Special Note:**

Existing law contains similar provisions for a first responder who witnesses an event (as opposed to a series of events) described in the bill.
