SENATE BILL 177

Imposes requirements governing Medicaid coverage of certain antipsychotic or anticonvulsant drugs. (BDR 38-82)

Senate Bill 177 codifies an existing requirement that Nevada Medicaid must automatically cover antipsychotic and anticonvulsant drugs under certain circumstances and extends this requirement to health maintenance organizations and managed care organizations that provide coverage to Medicaid recipients. Additionally, this bill authorizes the Commissioner of Insurance to suspend or revoke the certificate of authority of a health maintenance organization or other Medicaid managed care organization that fails to comply with the bill's provisions.
