SENATE BILL 314 (R1)

Revises provisions relating to energy storage systems. (BDR 58-60)

Sponsored By: Senator Lange, et al.
Date Heard: May 11, 2023
Fiscal Notes: Effect on Local Government: No.
Effect on the State: Yes.

Senate Bill 314 requires the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada to establish biennial targets for certain electric utilities in order to provide the greatest benefits to customers in relation to the cost of procuring energy storage systems. The bill requires licensed individuals to install electrochemical energy storage systems in conformance with certain standards.

Finally, the bill authorizes a provider of a training program for the installation of electrochemical energy storage to request the Joint Interim Standing Committee on Growth and Infrastructure to review the program and for the Committee to include recommendations regarding the same in its final report.

Amendments: Assembly Committee on Growth and Infrastructure:

- Removes the authorization to have a training program for the installation of electrochemical energy storage request the Joint Interim Standing Committee on Growth and Infrastructure to review the program by deleting subsection 3 of Section 3.
