SENATE BILL 291

Makes various changes relating to education. (BDR 34-503)

Sponsored By: Senators Cannizzaro, Dondero Loop, Lange, Flores, and Neal, et al.
Date Heard: May 29, 2023
Fiscal Notes: Effect on Local Government: May have Fiscal Impact.
Effect on the State: Contains Appropriation not included in Executive Budget.

Senate Bill 291 removes the requirement that a student teacher must have completed at least four weeks of student teaching in a school district to qualify for employment as a substitute teacher. Additionally, the bill appropriates \$1,575,000 to Nevada's Department of Education for the Nevada Institute on Teaching and Educator Preparation and requires the Institute to report to the Interim Finance Committee on each expenditure made from this money.
