**ALLEGATION/S:** Alleged violation of NRS 625.  
**SUMMARY:** Respondent submitted plans for a project to the City of Henderson Building and Safety Department which were prepared by the Complainant.  
**STATUS:** Accepted a stipulation and decision to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$1,000; reimbursement to the Board of investigative costs in the amount of \$1,134; successfully complete the Texas Tech University, Murdough Center for Engineering Professionalism, Engineering Ethics Correspondence Course within one year; and pass the Board's open-book exam on Nevada law within 90 days.

**STATUS:** Accepted a stipulation and decision to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$1,500; reimbursement to the Board of investigative costs in the amount of \$250; and notification to his clients in writing that he was not licensed when he performed engineering services for them and to pay the costs of any corrections or restamping of documents. Upon compliance with the terms of the stipulated agreement, Mr. Keyes' license will be reinstated.

**SUMMARY:** Respondent signed, stamped, and submitted structural calculations to the Building Department outside his discipline of mechanical engineering.

**STATUS:** March 3, 2005, formal disciplinary hearing before the board: Mr. Feskens license was suspended for two years with the suspension stayed; placed on probation for two years; ordered to comply with the standards of practice of professional engineering in the State of Nevada; refrain from practicing civil engineering in the State of Nevada until he is licensed in the discipline of civil engineering; shall submit quarterly reports setting forth the nature and scope of the work performed by him in Nevada during the term of his probation; was assessed an administrative fine in the amount of \$1,000 to be paid within 30 days; and reimbursement to the Board of investigative costs in the amount of \$506.
